CHURCH FELLOWSHIP



Thank you for supporting the first month of our **Community Outreach** to our homeless neighbors and others in similar difficult circumstances. Since the Church Fellowship will not meet during the summer, here is our donation focus for the next several months.

April – travel sized personal hygiene items and flip flop sandals in various sizes. These will be donated to a mobile shower ministry serving the homeless in St. Lucie County.

May – diapers and wipes; feminine hygiene products.

June – shorts and t-shirts (new or like new) for men and women.

July – school supplies

August – socks, underwear, bras for all ages and sizes – must be new and in the package and/or have tags on.

September – to be determined in August

A list of all these will be posted on the bulletin board so you can plan ahead for your donations. And there will be a flyer posted over the donation box monthly to highlight that month's donation focus. Note that we also need reusable (not plastic) grocery bags to help with distribution. And, if you have an idea for a donation focus, or a local organization that serves this type of need in our community, let us know. We would like to work with a variety of local outreach groups!

Our April meeting will be a luncheon at Crabby's Dockside (downtown at the Fort Pierce Marina) on Tuesday, April 16, at 11:30. Everyone is welcome! There will be a sign-up sheet on the bulletin board (or let Patricia or Terry know) so we can be sure we have room for everyone.

CHURCH COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES FEBRUARY 11, 2024

Attendance: Joel Reif, Pastor; Carol Sinotte, Moderator; Dickie Brooks, Clerk; Doug MacWilliam, Deacons; Mary Keller, Treasurer; Janis Gonzalez, Music; Dick Sinotte, Property; Patricia Bryant, Church Fellowship, and Rachel Spence, IT Support.

Joel opened the meeting with a prayer.

Clerk's Report – Dickie submitted the minutes from the February 11, 2024, meeting. The minutes were approved as submitted.

Treasurer's Report – Mary submitted the report which was approved as submitted. She reported that the adjustments made to our property insurance coverages and limits reduced the annual premium from \$14,262 to \$9,121.

Pastor's Report – Joel reminded that he will be on vacation the weeks of Sunday, April 21, and Sunday, April 28. Doug will lead worship on those dates.

Property – Dick reported that things have been very quiet on the general maintenance front. Patricia reported she had received an anonymous donation to cover cleaning of the front window in the sanctuary and hopes to get that completed before Easter Sunday.

Music – Janis reported she's divided the Easter/Lenten music program into 3 parts, two of which were presented last Sunday and today (Palm Sunday) and the third will be presented on Easter Sunday.

Stewardship – Dickie reported that we usually send out our annual stewardship letter in the spring. She volunteered to write the letter and assemble for mailing, targeting within the next 2 weeks. She opened a discussion about online giving and turned the discussion over to Rachel who explained generally how that would work. The Council agreed that Rachel should pursue that for us.

Nominating – Dickie presented a proposed slate of officers and committees for the 2024-2025 church year for discussion. There were some additions and adjustments and a slate was approved for presentation at the Annual Meeting on April 14.

Memorial – Dickie read a report from Elaine that all name and year plaques have been received and those are now up to date. Plaques will be placed on the boards in the near future.

Church Fellowship – Patricia reported that there will be no yard sales or Christmas Bazaar this year. We just do not have the people resources to continue to hold those as we have in the past. Realizing that these fundraisers do help support the church's operating budget, several ideas for replacement income were discussed and will be further discussed at the Church Fellowship meeting this coming Tuesday. Also at that meeting, officers will be elected for the coming year and a decision will be made on our annual community outreach donations.

Deacons, Trustees, Missions, and Evangelism – No reports.

Old business – Joel reminded that we need to complete the updating of the Church Bylaws. Carol and Dickie committed to working on that over the summer.

The next Council Meeting will be May 19, 2024.

Joel adjourned the meeting with prayer.
